


Child Sponsorship

At the core of our mission is our child sponsorship program. In January of 2010, we had **17** sponsored children who were supported monthly. By December of 2010, we had grown to **40** children who were supported on a monthly basis through Give2GiveHope. This growth is a **235%** increase in monthly sponsorship from the beginning of the year through December's sponsorship.

By early January 2011, this number had increased to **44** children and it's anticipated to continue to grow through this calendar year.



We based our 2011 budget on 40 children and are thrilled to have exceeded that number already. Our operational expenses should only increase marginally so that a greater percentage of our overall revenue will be dedicated directly to support the children and other projects affecting the living conditions of the Give2GiveHope children. **88%** of all child sponsorship donations received go directly to provisions for the children.

Board of Directors

We had two new board members join us in 2010. Jennifer Wisser and Andrea Deering both attended the VisionCatcher 2010 mission trip and were deeply impacted by the experience. They each have a vision and a deep desire to help the children be lifted out of, and break, the cycle of poverty and they have a passion for the work of Give2GiveHope. We are happy to welcome them to our team and are blessed by their partnership.


From Our President

In June, we led our first mission trip to Sapadril, Honduras - VisionCatcher 2010. 15 people joined us for 8 days - June 24th through July 1st.

Our primary focus for the trip was to update the registration information for the 113 children we had registered in our system from 2009. On our registration day, we had 102 of the original 113 children come to update their information. In addition to our existing registered children, we had 182 new children show up to register for our program. Our child registration grew by 278% in just one week!

We brought with us 137 pair of flip-flops, approximately 50 t-shirts, 164 toothbrushes and varying quantities of toothpaste, soaps, shampoo, small gifts, hand-made dolls, and some clothing. This obviously wasn't enough supplies to ensure all 280 children received one of every item, so our goal for our VisionCatcher 2011 is to collect and take 300 of every item.

A secondary goal of our trip was to build a new outdoor kitchen area for Monte de Santidad church, which is the ministry we partner with to ensure the Give2GiveHope program functions in Honduras. We raised an additional \$2400 to be able to build a block foundation, a cement slab, cement counters, and to rebuild the outdoor oven and buy a new refrigerator. In addition, the team contributed additional funds to pay workers and purchased many kitchen accessories for the kitchen workers to use to make food for future mission teams.

We had a small issue with our airline going on strike and having to re-book our flights and modify our dates, but overall the trip was a tremendous success. All the participants had an incredible experience and "caught the vision" for the work God is doing all around them. We couldn't have asked for a better "first" trip and are excited to see what God does on our upcoming VisionCatcher 2011 mission trip and how our ministry continues to grow.

Marketing & Promotions

Our first brochure was printed in August. In addition to the brochure, we had our first postcards, first sponsor communication cards, thank you cards, and Christmas donation cards printed. We also now have Give2GiveHope ink pens to hand out when we present.

To help raise funds we sold non-woven grocery totes and Christmas ornaments this year. We were able to sell 141 bags and raise \$1400 for bulk food purchases, and sold 36 Ornaments (\$600 raised) for our construction project.




The Give2GiveHope Facebook page was launched July 15th, shortly after we returned from the VisionCatcher trip. The Facebook page is co-managed by Jennifer Wiser and Ken Hayes, board members. We currently have over 300 "fans", which is considerable growth in under 6 months. In the web area, our site was tweaked and upgraded several times during the year and we continue to adjust it to bring more functions and features to our sponsors and visitors.

Our first e.Newsletter launched in late September. The e.Newsletter is edited by Andrea Deering, board member. We sent out an October edition, a December edition, and a year-end giving letter in 2010. Currently our subscription base is approximately 120 subscribers and we continue to grow that list through our website sign-up and at any events we attend.

Give2GiveHope had the opportunity to participate in, and present at, many functions in 2010.

We kept pretty busy traveling and sharing with others the mission of our organization. Here are a few highlights from our year:

- In May we presented at New Beginnings Church in Hillman, Michigan where the congregation gave us a great 'send off' for our mission trip.
- St. Joseph Catholic School in West Branch had "Give2GiveHope Day" in June where the children donated funds and hygiene items for our trip and we shared with the kids what it would be like to be a child living in Honduras (much different than a child living in the US).
- Give2GiveHope was the Vacation Bible School "missionary" at Temple Baptist Church in Cadillac, MI in July. The kids and adults raised over \$900 for us which we used to sponsor a child and to cover the cost of our "Bag of Hope" bags which we used for our bulk food fund raiser.
- We were also able to share a little about Give2GiveHope at the "Mentors in Mission" program in December with St. Mary's of Michigan mentor candidates. We also were excited to be invited to make three different "Diversity Days" presentations at St. Mary's of Michigan who has supported us through donations of medicines each time we have made a trip to Honduras.



2011 Goals Our goals for 2011 include the following (in no particular order):

- Presentations at Handley School in Saginaw and Genesee Christian School in Burton
- Finalization and printing of our banner display to be used at presentations
- Working with Jonny Carroll (song writer) on a Give2GiveHope project
- VisionCatcher 2011 mission trip planned for late June 2011
- Updating profiles for existing children and accepting new registrations
- Creation of a video presentation for Give2GiveHope for use in presentations / web
- Artwork project while in Honduras with the Give2GiveHope children
- Fall fund-raiser dinner (date TBD) including an art auction of g2gh children's artwork
- Administrative work trip in September of 2011
- Development of the ability to take credit cards via our website
- Acquisition (through donation or purchase) of a laptop for Honduras ministry
- Construction of a storage space for bulk food purchases in Honduras
- Begin bulk food purchasing once storage space is finalized
- Participation in additional presentations as opportunities present
- Seek additional volunteers to assist us with operations - both in Honduras and US
- Explore "clean water" solutions to determine how Give2GiveHope can expand services
